## Federal Requirement

- Foster Care Youth cohort to be surveyed at ages 17, 19, and 21
- Federal cohorts are youth in foster care as of his/her $17^{\text {th }}$ birthday, every third federal fiscal year starting with 2011 (FFY11, FFY14, FFY1 7, etc.)
- Federal Fiscal Year 2011 was the first cohort:
- FFY11=Baseline; FFY13 and FY15=Follow-up
