Small Counties & Rare Outcomes


In small counties or for indicators in which the outcome is rare, a change in one or two children can create a large change in performance, and a large percent change, from one period to the next. In these cases, such a large change may not be cause for alarm. If performance is not shown for a given period or indicator, it means there were no children eligible for the indicator and therefore no performance to report.

Dashboard Update Schedule




This dashboard is updated Monthly to reflect the most recent available data. For each update, performance is shown for a new "12-month cohort" of children.


Question: How many victimizations occurred for every 100,000 days that children were in care during the 12-month period?





