



FEDERAL LAW HAS CHANGED SNAP

WHAT YOU CAN DO TO SUPPORT MARYLANDERS



H.R. 1, as passed by Congress and signed into law by President Trump, adds red tape and imposes work requirements on up to 80,000 additional SNAP recipients. Community partners are key to helping Maryland families navigate these new barriers.

HOW YOU CAN TAKE ACTION

Spread the word to help Marylanders stay informed:

- Invite customers to continue to update their information, check their eligibility, and apply for help at MarylandBenefits.gov.
- Direct customers to the DHS H.R.1 website at dhs.maryland.gov/important-changes-snap-benefits/ for employment resources and additional details on impacted individuals.
- Encourage customers to read and respond to notices from DHS as we work to deliver seamless benefits access despite these new federal barriers.
