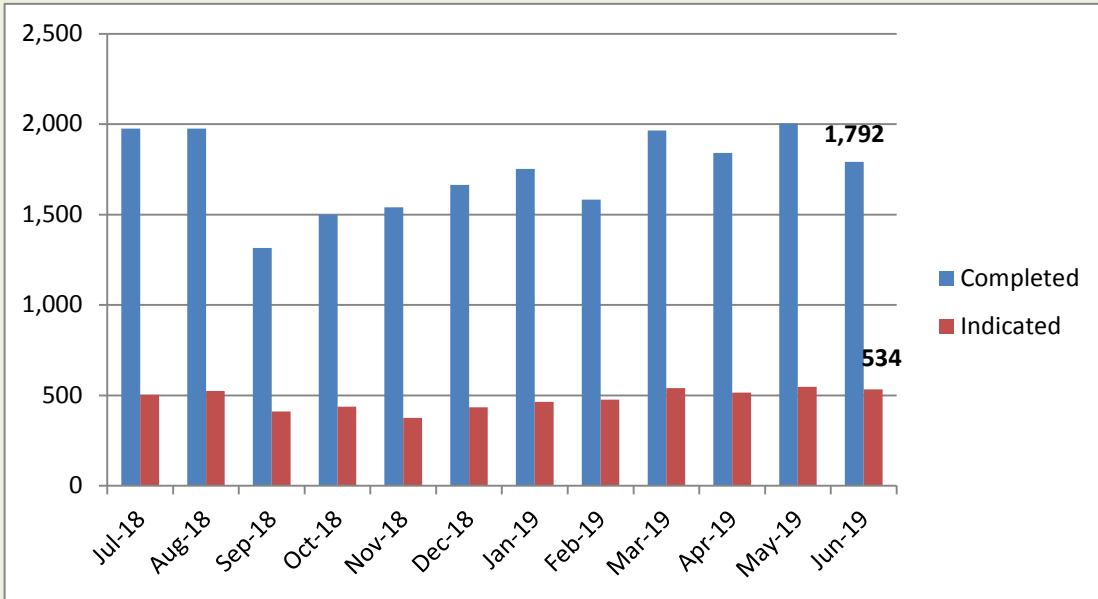

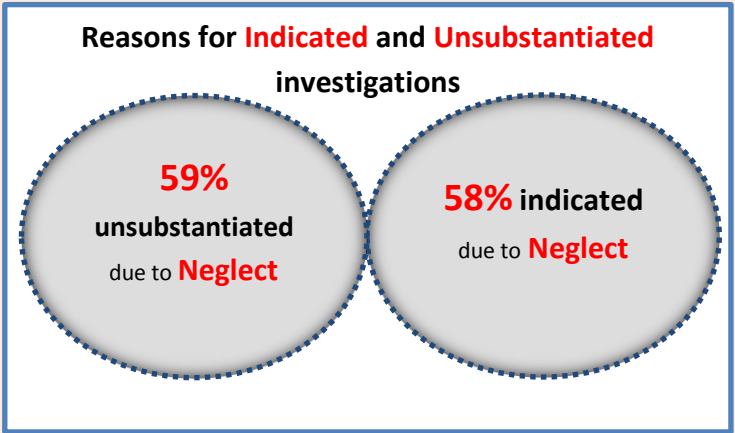

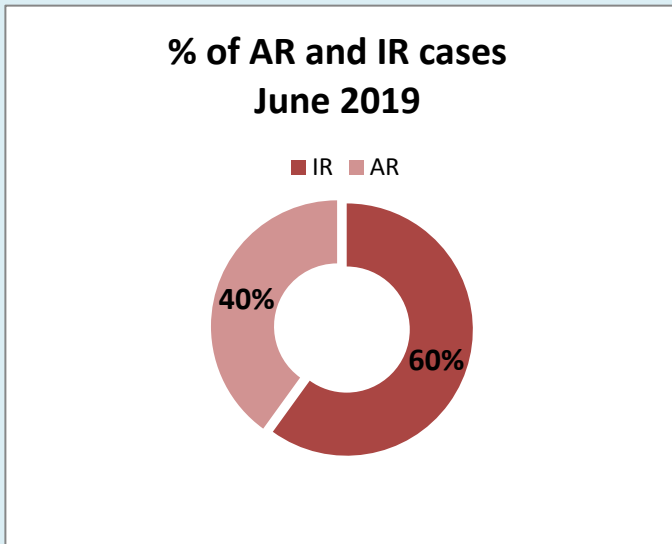

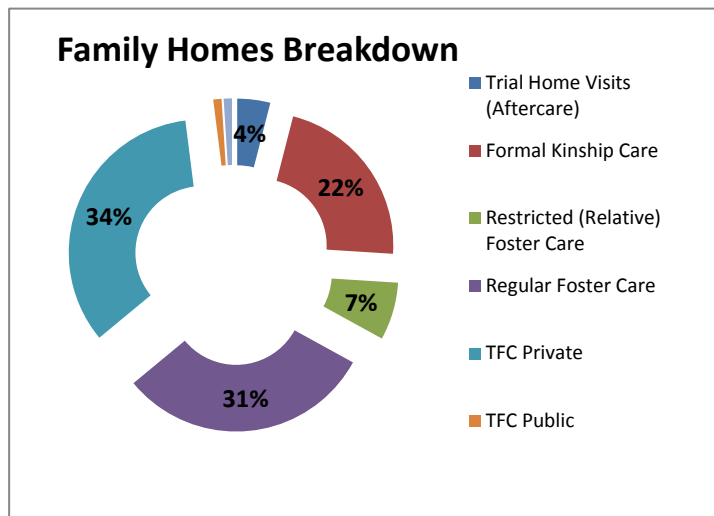
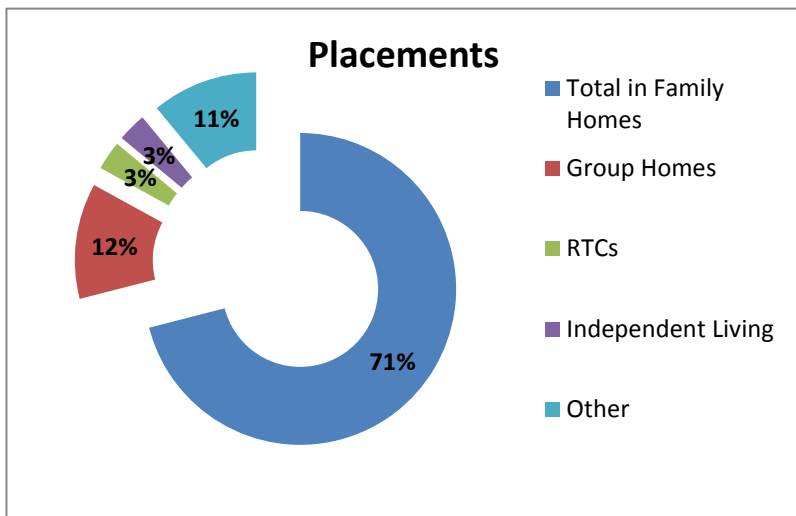
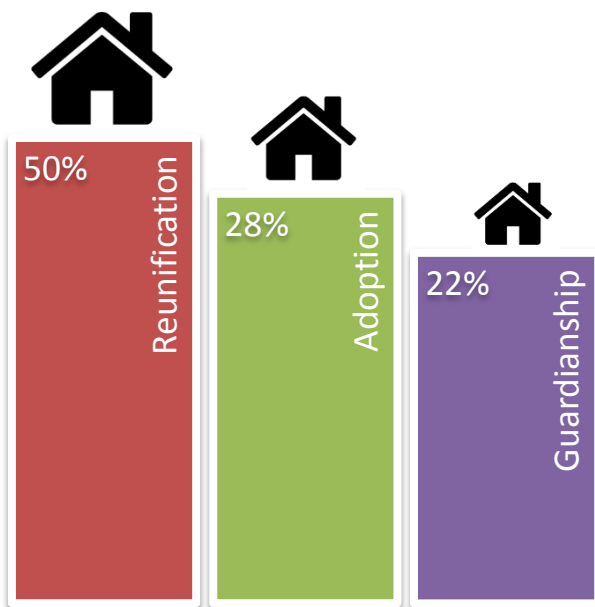

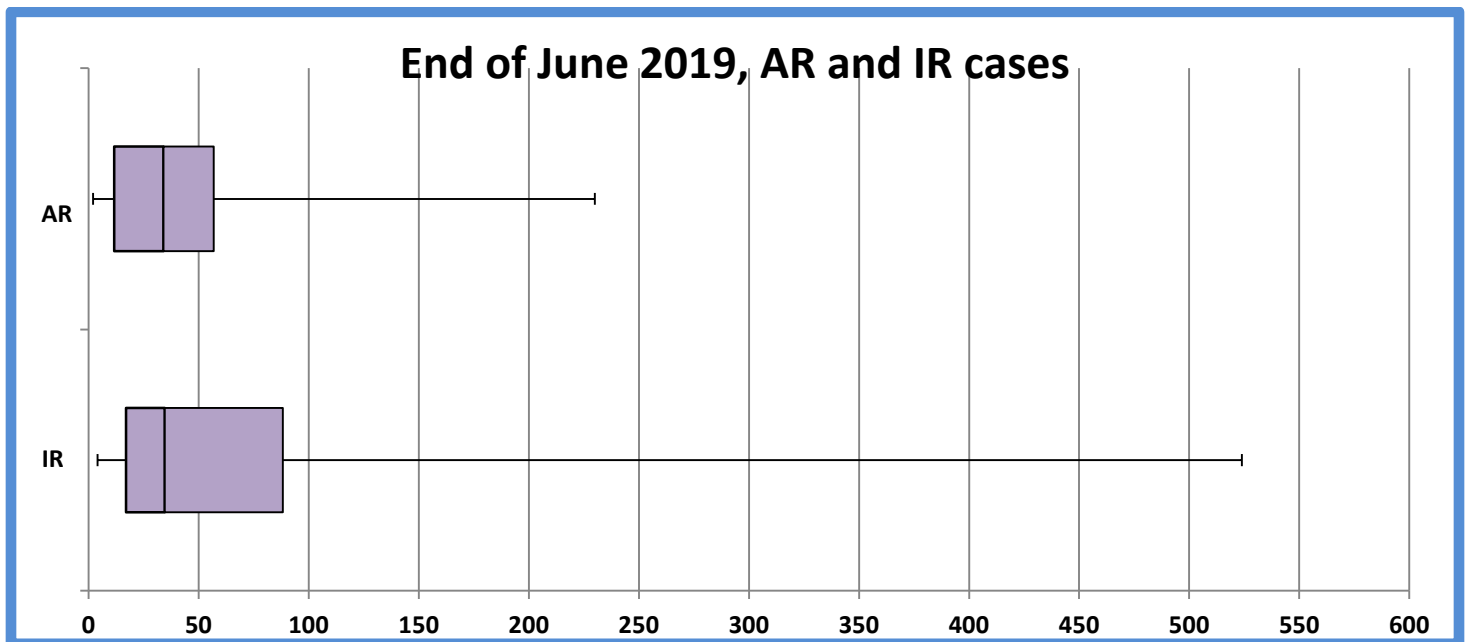

This chart displays the distribution of AR and IR cases for the end of June 2019 in Maryland. The middle “box” represents the middle 50% of values for the group. At the end of June, the counts of 50% of AR cases were about 10 to 60 and the counts of 50% of IR cases were about 20 and 90. The median value for both AR and IR cases was about 30, in which there was no change from the previous month. The whiskers represent values outside the middle 50%. The max number of AR cases was about 200, while for IR cases it was about 500. The size of the box for AR is smaller than IR, meaning the data for AR is more similar than the data for IR.
