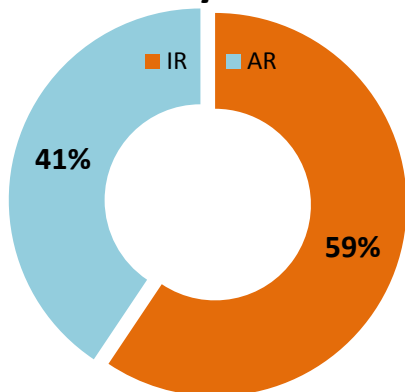

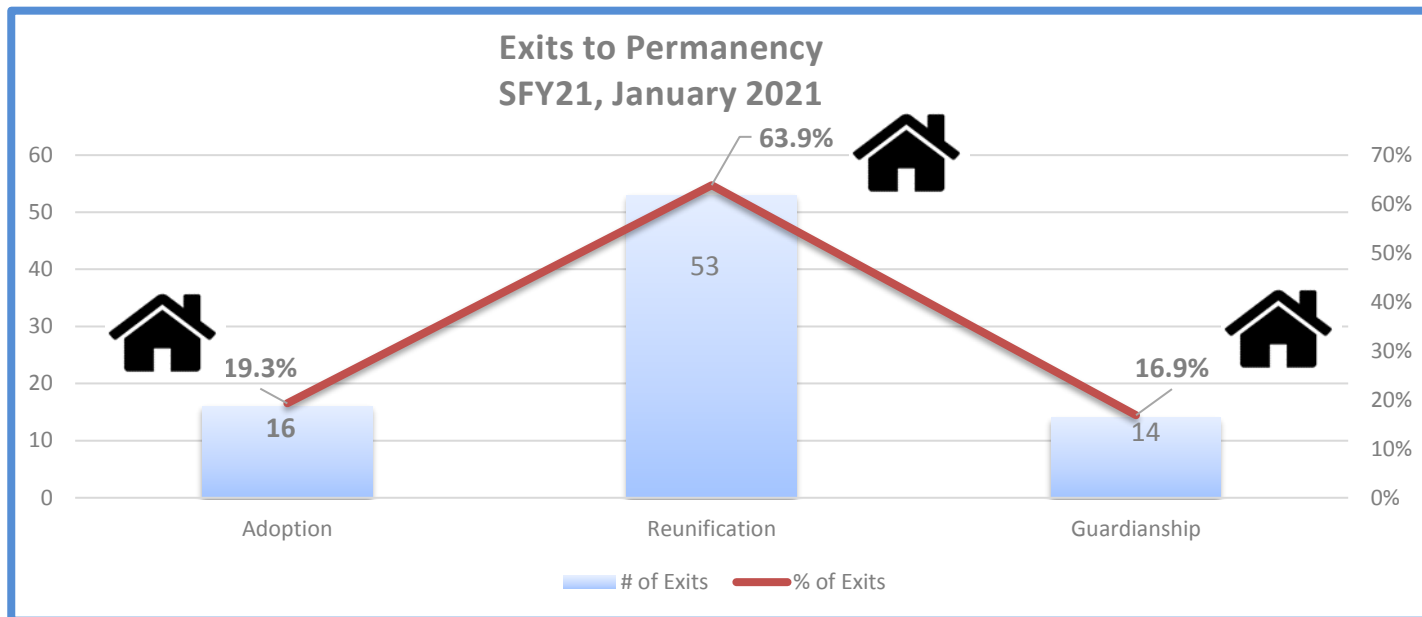

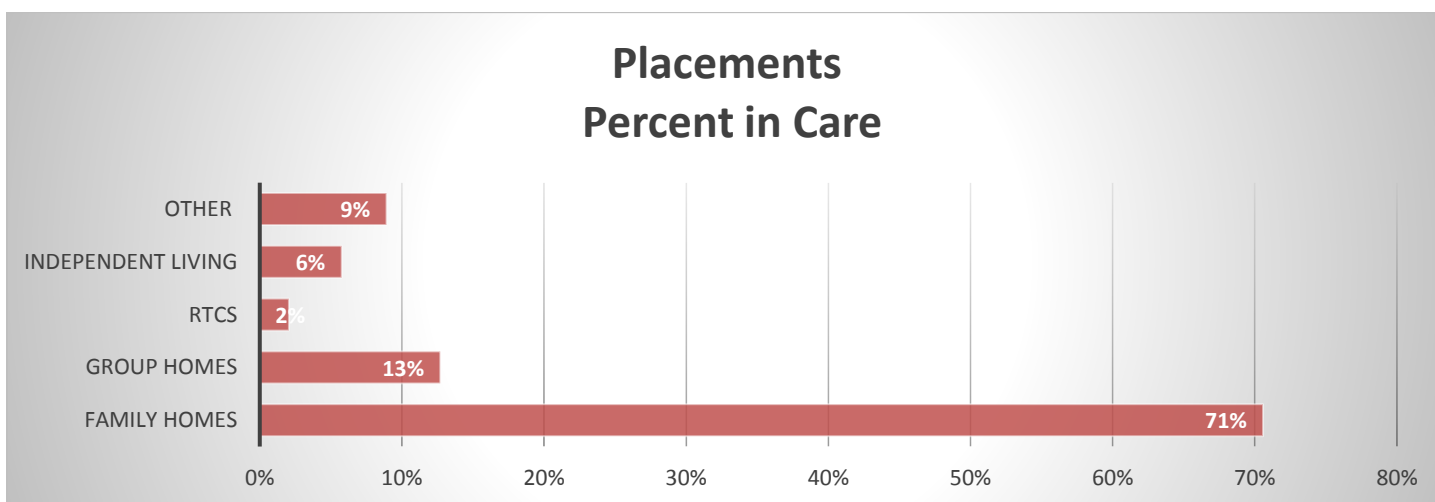
% of AR and IR cases January 2021



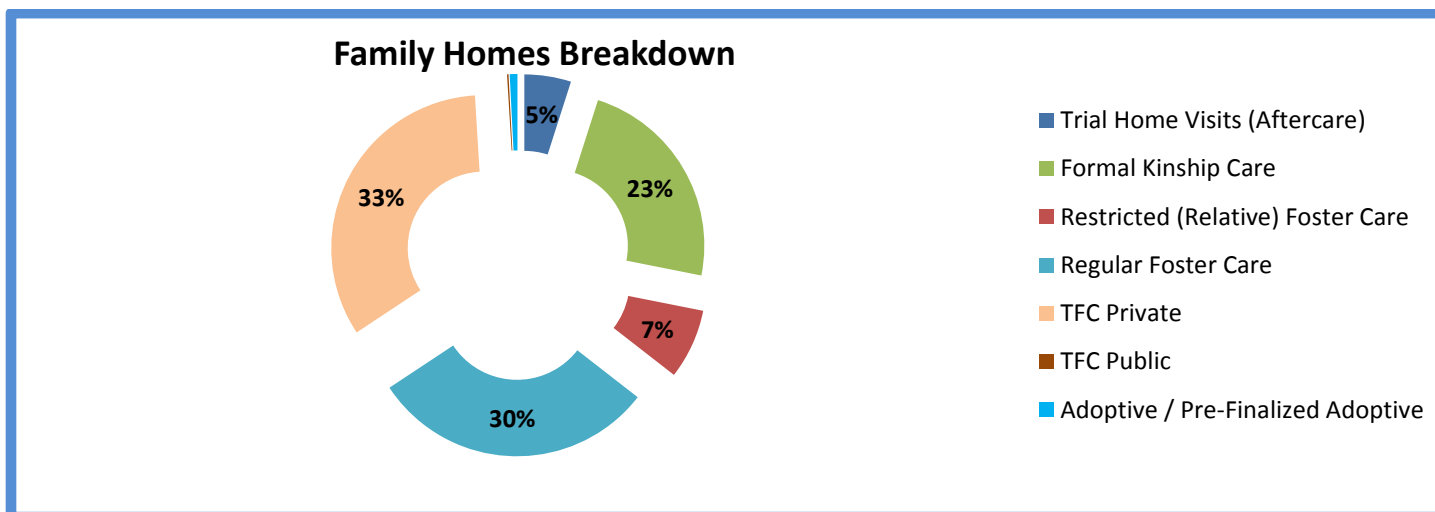

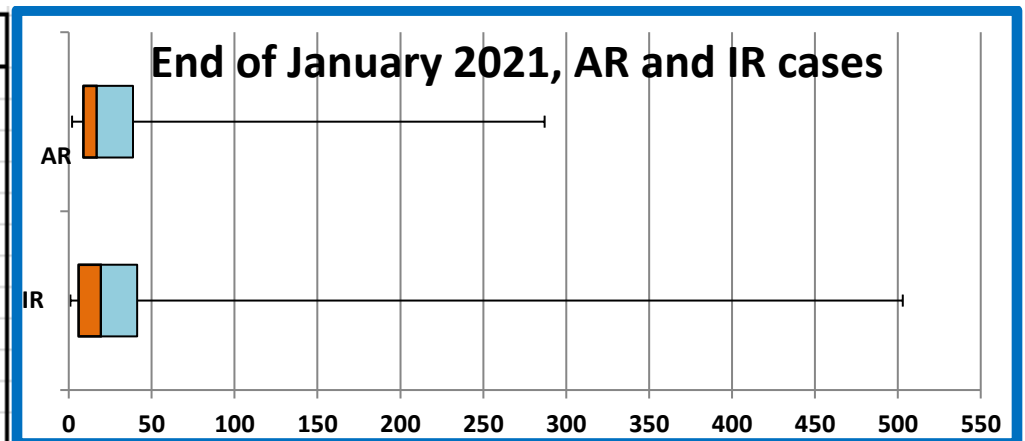

This chart displays the distribution of AR and IR cases for the end of January 2021 in Maryland. In the diagram, the middle "box" represents the middle 50% of the values. The median value for AR and IR was about 20 with no change from last month. At the end of January, the 3rd quartile represents 50% of AR and IR cases. The whiskers represent values outside the middle 50%, in which the top whisker was around 500 for IR and 200 for AR, respectively. The max number of IR cases was 57% more than AR cases. The size of the box for AR is smaller than IR, meaning the data for AR is more similar than the data for IR.
