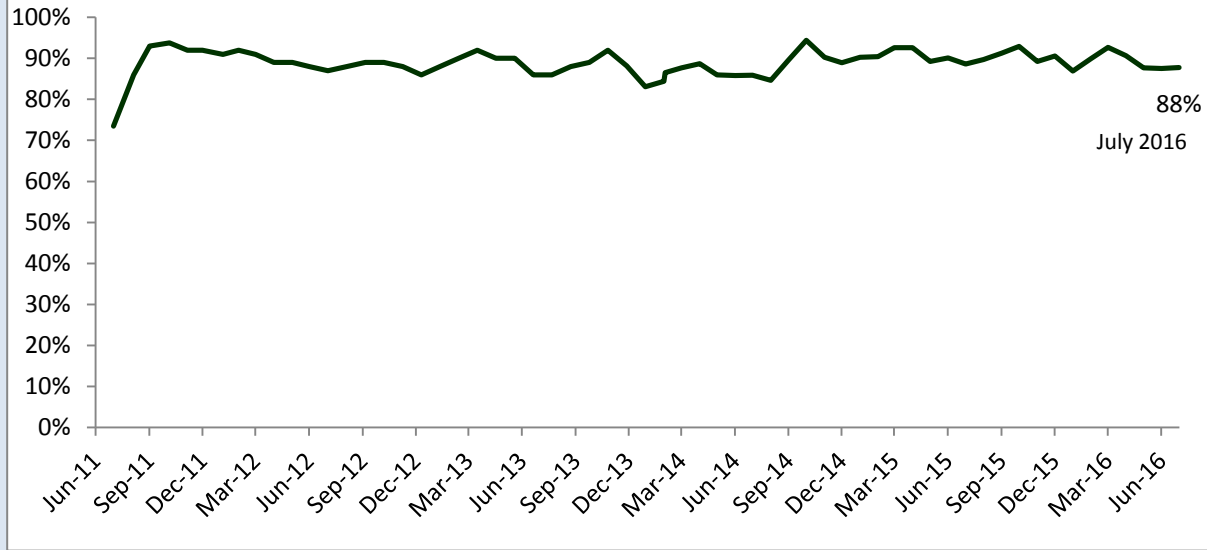

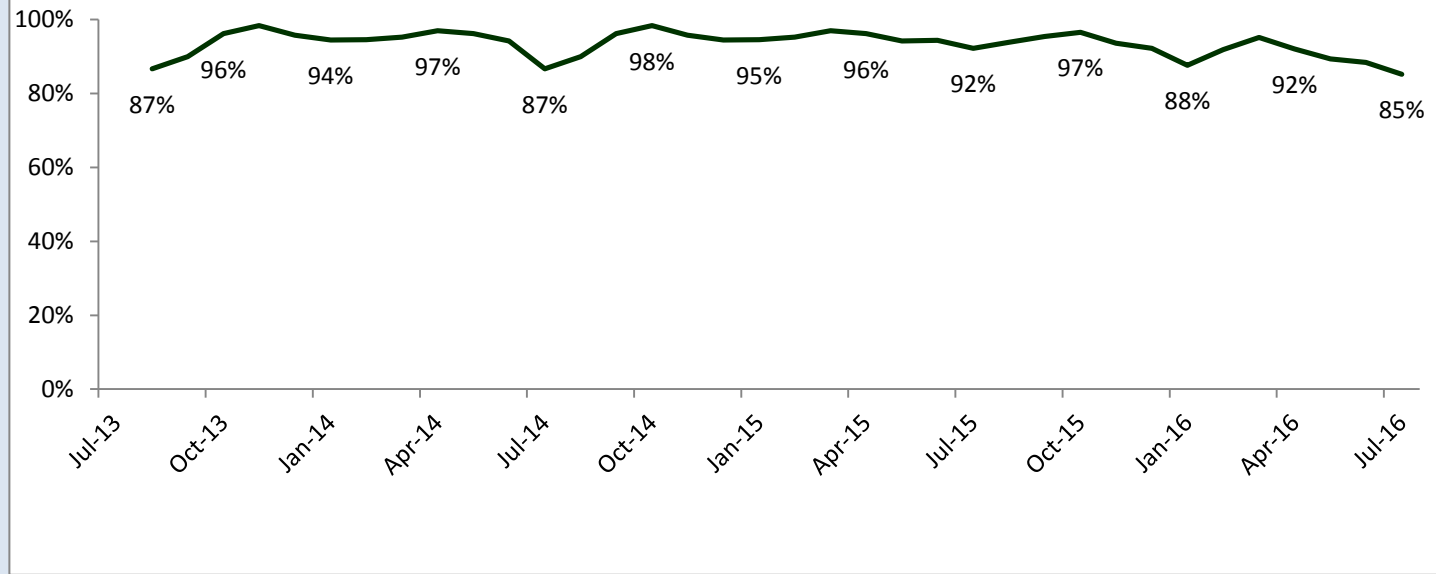

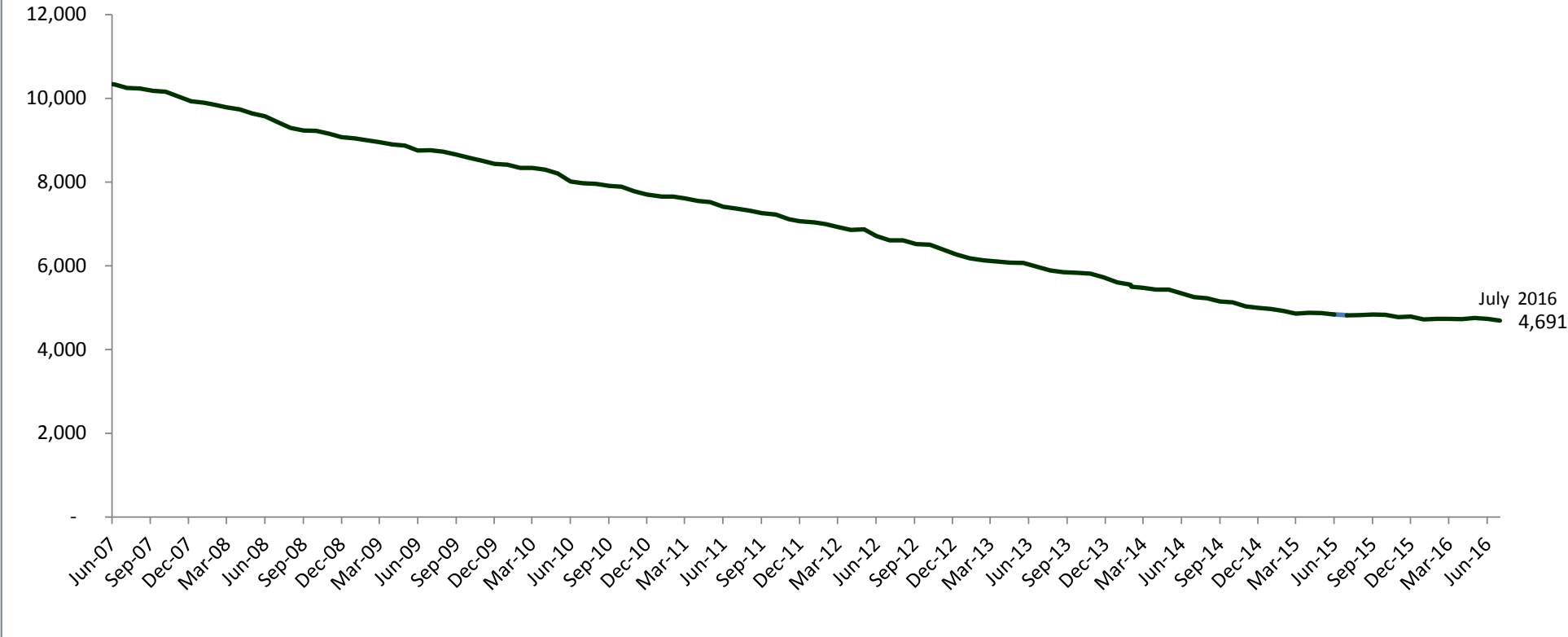

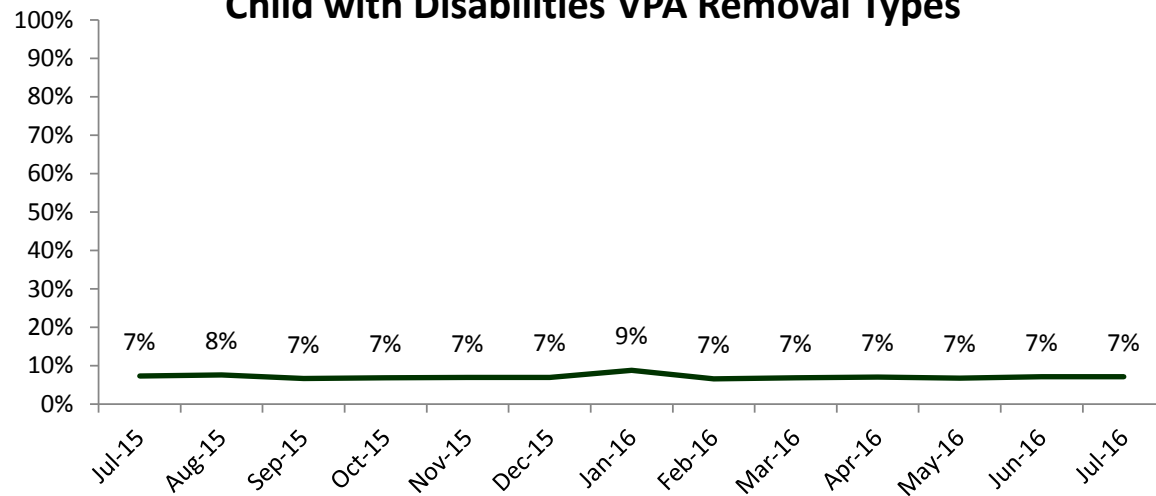


### Number of children in out of home placement



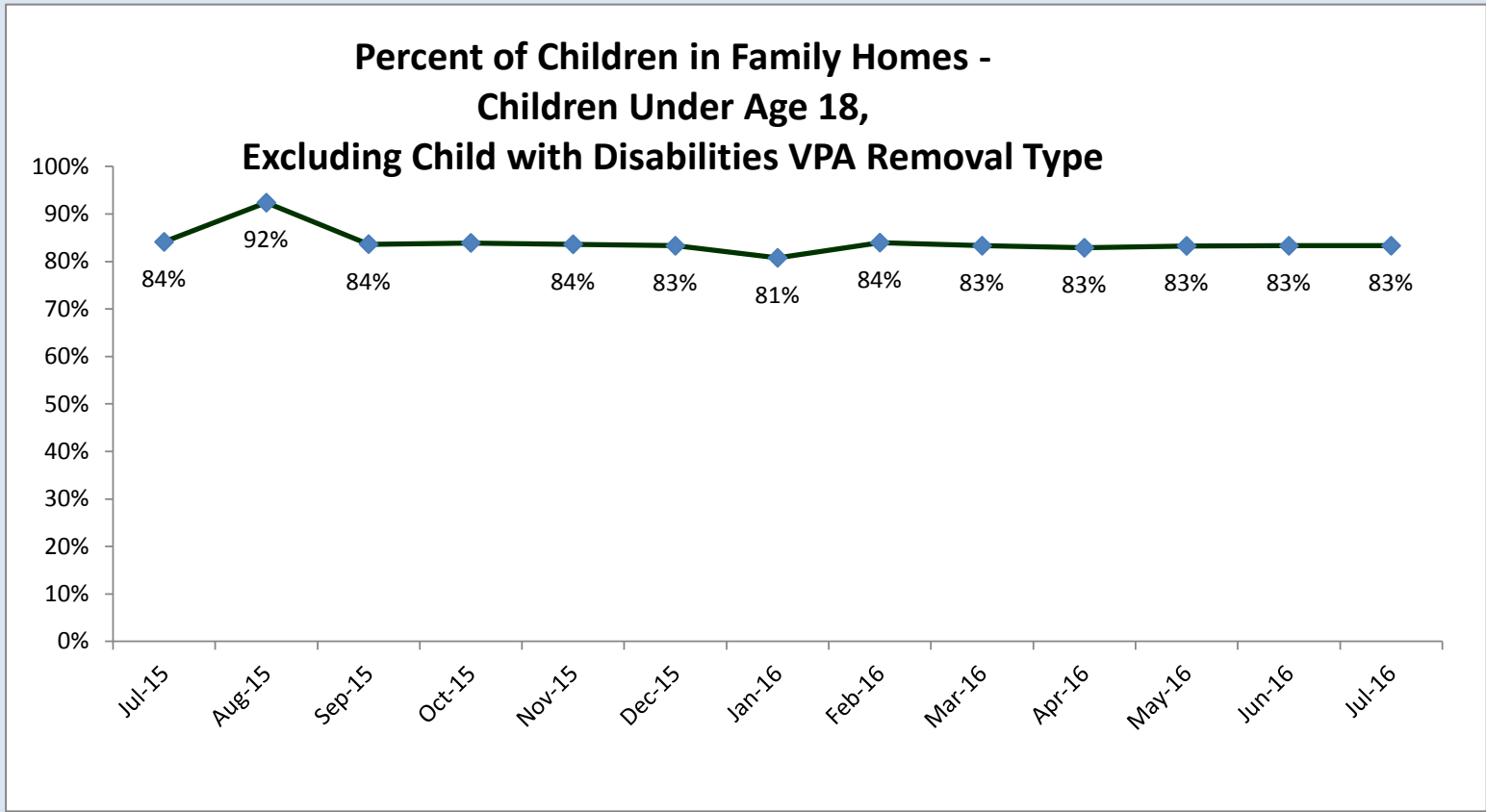

### Percent of Children in Group Homes - Children Under Age 18, Excluding Child with Disabilities VPA Removal Types

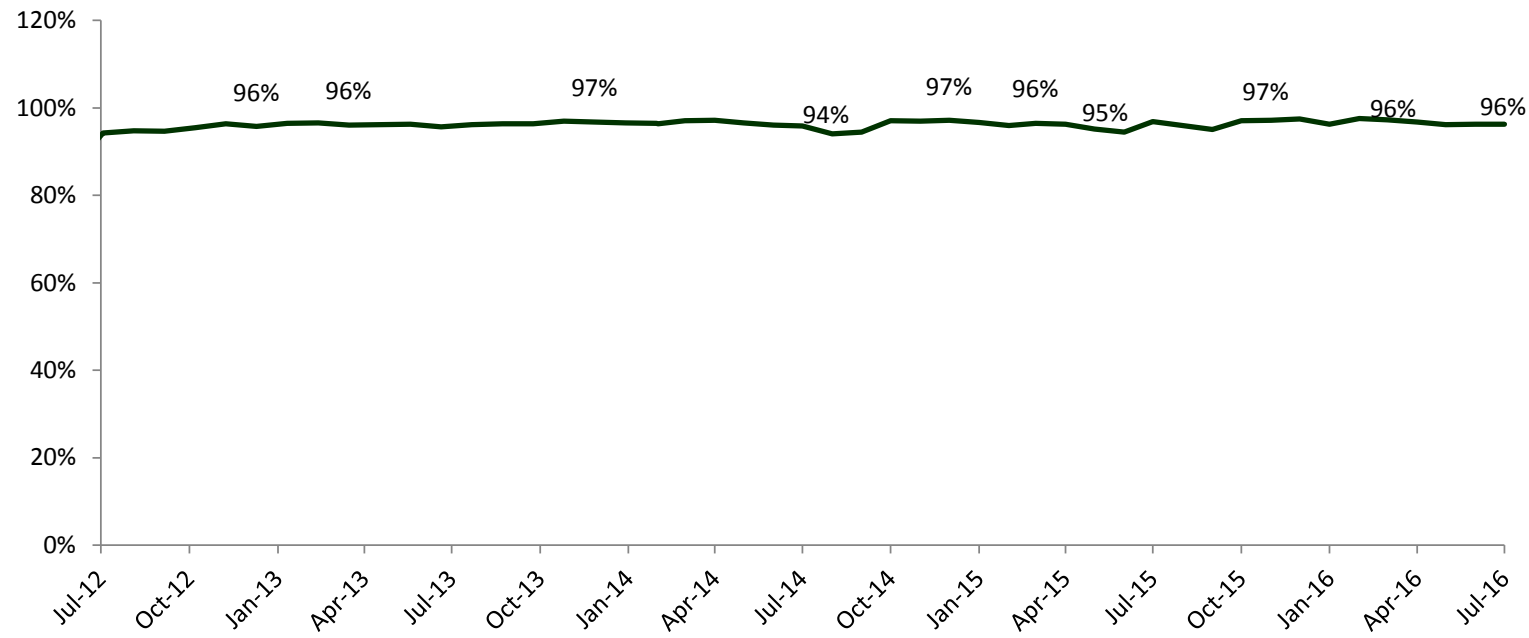

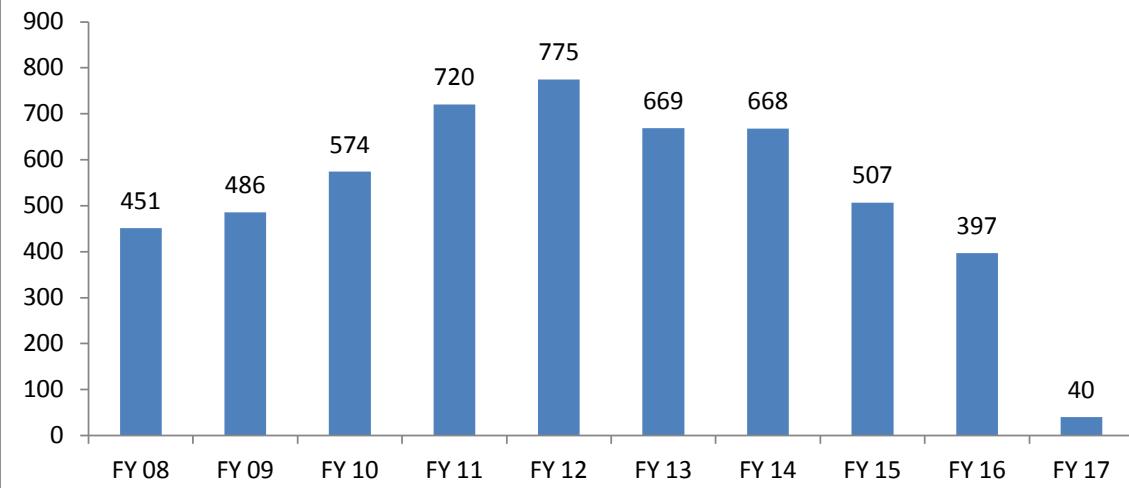


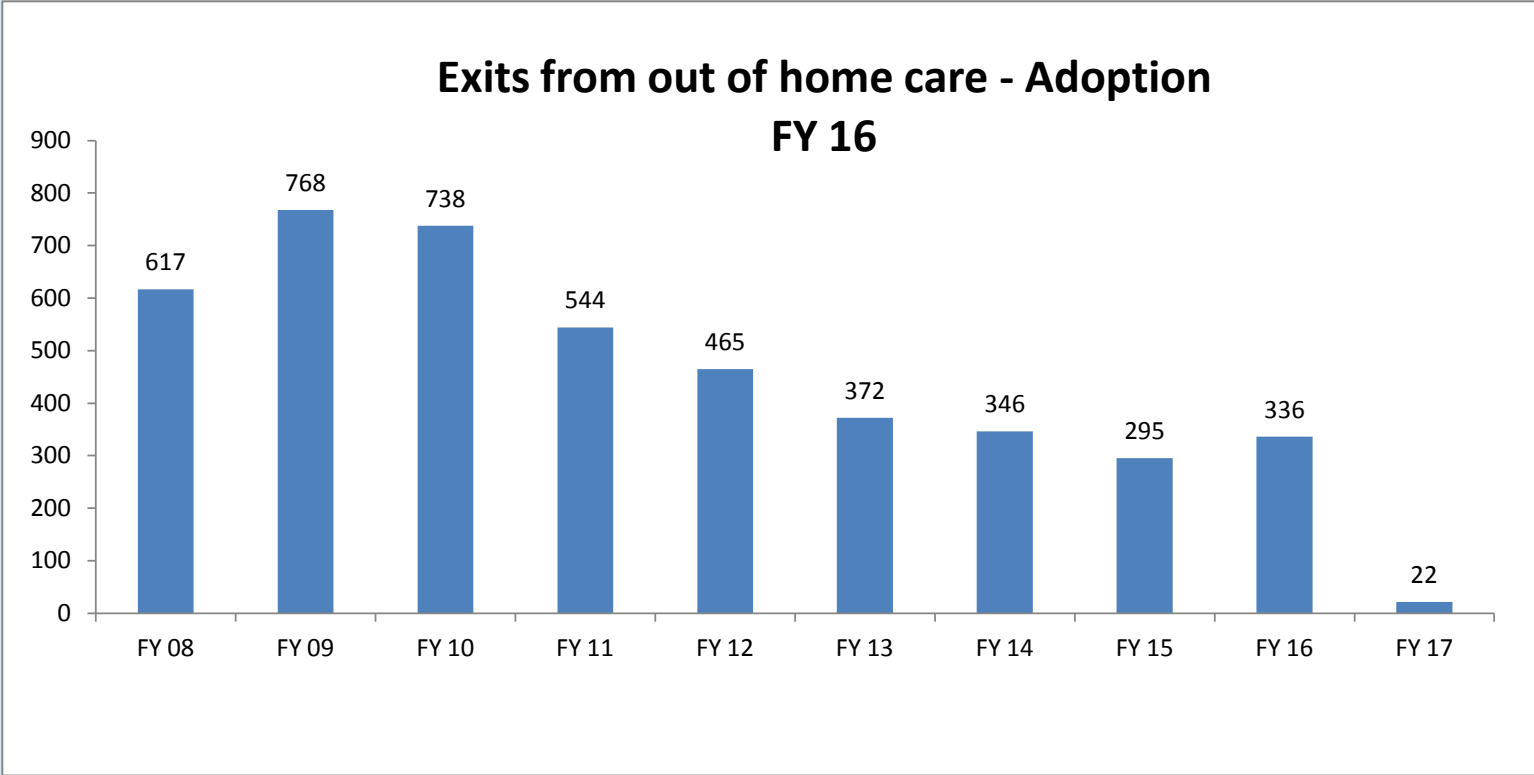
### Caseworker Visitation - percent of children in out of home care visited every month

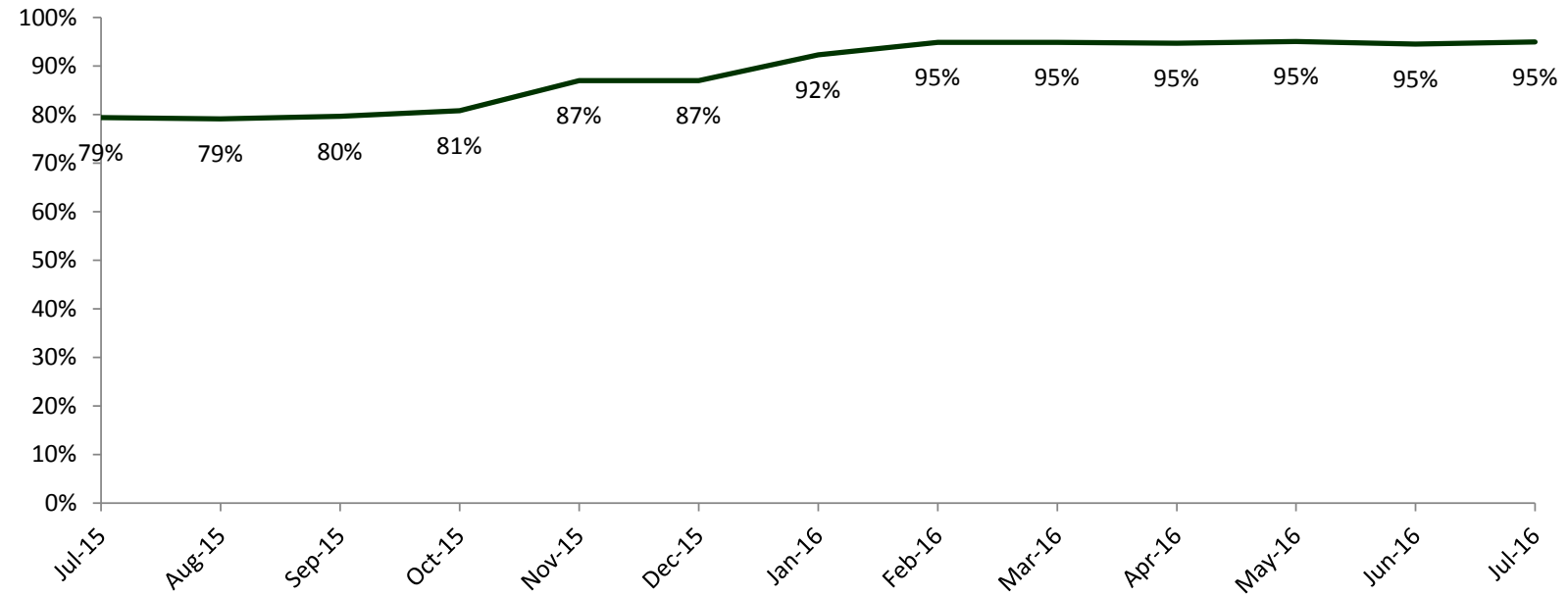
### Exits from out of home care - Guardianship FY16
